HEART KIDS NZ

Every week, 12 babies are born with a heart defect in New Zealand. Whilst there are surgical procedures that can improve the heart's function, there is no cure for a Congenital Heart Disease. 7 and a half years ago, Year 2 BBS student Maya Gourlay became part of this statistic having being born prematurely weighing just 1kg alongside her twin. She was diagnosed with an aortic coarctation and underwent three life saving surgeries in her first three months of life. Lucky enough to have miraculously had her live to tell the tale, we are on a mission to support organisations that supported us all those years ago. Last year Browns Bay School joined team Maya as we raised more than \$5000 for Starship Children's hospital, and this year we are so thrilled to have BBS back on the Team to support us once again. This time Maya is one of the faces of the nationwide appeal campaign for Heart Kids NZ.

Heart Kids NZ is New Zealand's only charity that focuses it's efforts on kiwi kids and their families affected by congenital heart defects right throughout their lives. They receive no government funding and have to fundraise for all its services which include practical and emotional support which is vital for those affected, helping them cope with the day-to-day challenges of living with a childhood heart condition.

For us, Heart Kids provided information, support and a hand to hold in those dark days where Maya's survival was touch and go. They continued to support us through our subsequent 'un Heart related' hospital admissions and offer family events to meet other heart kids and their families. Most unique are the camps they run for older heart kids which are attended by medical personal where requiring medication and being unable to keep up with the pack, is the norm. For our Heart Kids feeling 'normal' is a luxury they so rarely have, so it's super important that charities like Heart Kids spread awareness so they are able to continue to operate at their best.

Maya's broken heart may have been mended, but there are more and more Kiwi Kids adding to the statistics every day who need our support and we are so grateful to you all for help.
