## PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

Dear Parents and Caregivers

### **ALERT LEVEL 3 PART TIME SCHOOLING**

We have been delighted to welcome 250 students on Wednesday and 234 students on Thursday back to school. At school the teaching programme has aimed to provide opportunities for students to connect with each other and socialise in a safe way. Teachers provided time for the children to talk about their anxieties and share their stories of lockdown. Teachers were also keen to get back to work with children in reading, writing and maths, as well as engaging in outdoor activities and art. At the break times it was great to see the playgrounds back in use.

We have been preparing the classrooms and our systems to ensure we are able to minimise the risk of someone getting infected and ensuring we can identify and contact anyone who has been in close contact if someone in the school is infected.

The key messages are:

- Ensure people feeling generally unwell stay away from school
- Maintain physical distancing (students are not breathing on or touching each other and Year 4 to 6 students / teachers wear masks)
- Good hygiene practices
- Keep track of who is in school

### **PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

The school map (see below) shows the division of the school by Year groups. Each area has a playground and open space to spread out at break-times.

The Year groups have different gates to use. We are aware some families will be dropped off by parents and then come in via the wrong gates – for safety reasons we will allow mixed sibling groups to come in the same gate when this happens. They will then separate to their areas of the school. Please consider this plan when organising drop offs at the start of the day.

Teachers have reviewed classroom seating to ensure students have their own space. There are no large gatherings taking place at school and any singing will be outside the classrooms. The library is currently closed for whole classes, yet teachers can get class sets of books. Teachers and children are making great use of the mild (yet windy) weather and are teaching outdoors as much as possible.

The Year 4 to 6 students have been very impressive with their mask wearing behaviour.

Teachers will continue to encourage students to regularly wash and dry their hands, and to cough / sneeze into their elbows. Each classroom has supplies of soap, paper towels, hand sanitiser, wipes and disinfectant spray. All surfaces will be cleaned daily. Children can share equipment and use the playgrounds because they are using these good hygiene practices. The classrooms are well ventilated – too much on Wednesday with the wind howling through some rooms!

We have asked children to bring water bottles as the drinking fountains have been closed off for shared use.

**PARENTS ONSITE**

If a parent needs to come onsite for a specific reason they must wear a mask, register on the Covid App and on our school register in the Office.

**STAY HOME IF SICK**

Parents are asked to keep sick children at home. Symptoms to look out for are a cold, head cold, blocked ears, cough, sneezing, sore throat, chill's and a fever. Anyone with these symptoms should not enter school. If a child is showing these symptoms, parents will be asked to collect them from school.

\*We would expect a doctor's certificate or a recent negative Covid test result before a return to school\*

**DISTANCE LEARNING**

Distance Learning is available for students who are not on site. The Distance Learning grids will be available all the time yet Zooms will only be on the days the Teachers are off site. If you are keeping your child at home for any reason, then the Distance Learning programme will be available.

**BUBBLE CLASSES**

We continue to have three Bubble Classes for children of essential workers or those families who have no appropriate care option at home. These Bubble groups have separate play times to the other Year groups and remain with the Bubble all day to limit the number of interactions in the playground. Jo Hewitt is managing these Bubble classes.

**SCHOOL LUNCHES**

The school lunchroom is closed and school lunches are not available to order.

## **COVID CASE IN SCHOOL PLAN**

The Ministry of Education (MOE) and Health (MOH) have provided a very detailed resource for schools to use if this should occur at our school.

A brief outline of the plan is that when there is a confirmed case in the community, public health officials will undertake a case investigation and work closely with the confirmed case to identify any close contacts, including any connection to a school or early learning service.

Health officials will then contact either our regional Director of Education or the school directly to provide direction on contact tracing and other relevant information. The MOE will support with communications to the school community based on this public health advice.

If a staff member, parent or caregiver notifies us that they or their child are a confirmed case, we will contact our regional Director of Education, who will provide advice on the next steps. Their team will connect with public health services to seek advice on the next steps for our school.

We will be able to identify those in our school who may also be considered contacts, through our:

- timetable (which staff were onsite with which classes, groups, bubbles)
- attendance register
- visitor register

We have been provided with letter templates to support communications to our school community, including for any person(s) who may need to self-isolate and/or get tested.

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




