YEAR 4 - 6 CROSS COUNTRY FINAL

On Tuesday next week (23rd June, Week 11), we are holding the Senior Cross Country Final.

Save days are Wednesday 24th June and Friday 26th June. The 1st race will start at 11.10 am and then follow the order below:

We ask that if you are intending on coming along that you arrive before the 1st race (11.10 am) as we will require spectators to stay well clear of the course and runners. It is crucial that the course is clear for the runners, at all times.

The course will start and finish on the School Field. The children will be completing 1 lap outside the School Grounds (Hyde Rd, Browns Bay Rd, Miri Rd) and then 1 lap, partially inside the school grounds.

There will be **no access from the Browns Bay Road school gate once the races have started**. This is an important intersection on the course and we need to keep this area clear. If the weather is not looking good we will endeavour to do our best to make a call before school on the day.

YEAR 1 – 3 CROSS COUNTRY FINAL

The Year 1 to 3 Cross Country Final is planned to occur on Tuesday 30 June at 1.30pm. The children will need to wear appropriate clothes on the day i.e. shorts not longs and suitable footwear. Cross-country training has been part of our fitness program this term and we have encouraged all children to take part. The course is run inside the school grounds like previous years. There are teachers/ Y6 supervisors stationed all along the route. If your child is unwell or unable to take part in this event, please inform your child's teacher.

The students will assemble at 1.30pm and races will start at 1.40pm. The children will compete in Year levels as outlined below:

Year 0 - 1 girls and boys

Year 2 girls and boys

Year 3 girls and boys

We cannot give a start time for each year group - they will just race in that order. The children run the course quickly so the event is not that long! If wet weather or ground conditions mean a postponement we will send an email to parents at 12 Noon on the day. A "save" day is set for Wednesday 1 July.

We are currently taking registrations for children who are *not currently* registered to play Flippaball and would like to play in Terms 3 & 4.

A place in a team is dependent on spaces available in existing teams or numbers received to make new teams.
