Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora

Happy Lunar New Year – the Year of the Ox from 12 February.

Welcome back to the new school year, and a particularly warm welcome to the new students

and their families who have joined our school community this year. The school roll has continued its upward trend and we would encourage any parents with preschoolers to complete the online enrolment form as soon as possible.

We are pleased to welcome Liz Hammelburg to the Senior Leadership Team as our Associate Principal responsible for learning support. Liz comes with several years of teaching experience at all levels within Primary School. Most recently she has worked in Learning Support as a Resource Teacher for Learning and Behaviour (RTLB). It is through this liaison role with Browns Bay School that she has built relationships with the Browns Bay School staff and families and looks forward to being part of BBS.

PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT

Over the holiday break we have had a busy time on the school site in preparation for the New Build. Rooms 18 and 19 were transported onto the field for use later in the year as our school roll grows, while Rooms 20 and 21 were demolished. The Year 6 students have moved into their "Portacoms" for the year and they seem very happy in their new `village`.

The project for the New Build has been confirmed and contract signing is underway. The project is expected to begin once final consents are issued and the site is expected to be marked out in the next few weeks.

The plans for the New Build have been on display in the school office since late last year. There are QR Codes on the plans that will, when viewed through a smart phone, allow you to see a 360° panorama of the interior of the Build.

The fenced area for the site will be quite large and may intrude onto the Masterton Road footpaths.

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As well as a new classroom block we will have a finished product including extensive landscaping of:

- A new driveway to the Hall
- A huge water tank for water recycling and school irrigation
- New outdoor learning areas
- Shared gardening opportunities

We are quite excited with the prospect of the Build starting soon!

Room 1 to 7 Development

The new doors and decks have been built outside Rooms 1 to 7. We are awaiting an inspection this week before any further work can be done. We are appreciative of the parents using the designated doors to drop off and pick up their children who are in this block.
