

### **PRINCIPALS MESSAGE**

Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora

Welcome to Term 3 and to the new families who have joined us this term. A special welcome to our New Entrants in Room 2 with Carrie Lindsay. These children have had a delayed start to school while we were waiting for the rooms on the field to be ready. This class is almost full and our next New Entrant class will be in Room 1. I would also like to welcome Karen Mackay who starts in Room 8 replacing Sarah Pyke who has now moved to Christchurch.

This term has a full 10 week programme that the teams have already started. The main topics in each year level are:

We also have the ICAS Examinations in August challenging students in Science, Digital Technologies, English and Mathematics. In Sports we have Rugby, Hockey and Basketball games against our cluster schools, as well as the after school sports. The Arts is going to feature strongly with the Year 5 and 6 Production "Launch!" being performed in the last week of the term. Term 3 is a great time for getting really stuck into classroom learning with the only break being on 03 September with a Teacher Only Day.

### PARENT – TEACHER CONFERENCES

Thank you to all the parents who attended the Conferences in the last week of Term 2. Teachers had 578 interviews between them over the two nights and I hope they were informative. ### **EMERGENCY PLANNING**

Year 4

A key role of our job at school is to ensure the safety of students while they are in our care, this is a role we take very seriously. The school engages the services of Wade Harrison, Safety Consultant, to review the school's Emergency Plan each year. Wade is coming in to school on Tuesday 10 August to speak to the children about our emergency plans. We have two main plans, "lock down" or "evacuate". The children will know them as the GO or STAY procedures. We will be doing a trial of the "lock down" or "STAY" drill on that day. Each term we will practice either a "GO" or "STAY" drill to ensure we are prepared for any event.

### Weather Event

After 5 minutes the weather passed over and the children were able to leave safely. I apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused.

### PROPERTY UPDATE

The New Build continues to rise out of the wet clay outside the staffroom. The brickwork walls and columns that will support the building are taking shape. The new driveway up to the Hall has been excavated and has had gravel laid.

### Village on the Field

The "Village" on the field has grown by 2 classes which are now connected to the 4 relocatable classrooms already there. The Year 3 classes from Room 1 (now Room 30) and Room 2 (now Room 29) have moved into these rooms. The metal fences have been removed yet parts of the field are still not available due to mud issues.

#### Rooms 1 to 7

We are still waiting for the shade canopy outside Rooms 1 to 7. The builders are awaiting supplies from overseas to complete this project.
