DISCRETIONARY FUND APPLICATIONS TERM 2 2019

FOTS invites applications for funding of small-scale school activities/projects.

Each year FOTS allocates a proportion of money from fundraising activities to support the school and its students in the following ways:

- **Education Support**: books, teacher-aide resources, curriculum resources
- Sports: team sponsorship, uniforms, kits and equipment, coaching/refereeing resources
- Arts and Culture: music, dance, drama support/equipment
- Equipment: any assets, systems, or equipment that does not fit within other categories

Who can apply for funding?

Applications can be submitted by parents/caregivers, coaches, and staff members within Browns Bay School.

Every application must be 'sponsored' by an appropriate member of BBS staff. This is to ensure there is a genuine need for the funds outside the school's budget and so the sponsor staff member is aware that requirements are exceeding the budget.

How are applications made?

- Complete the attached one-page document as fully as possible please include estimates including GST and freight.
- **IMPORTANT:** A relevant staff sponsor must support and approve your application with a signature this is to ensure there is no existing funding sources already available for your project.
 - o e.g. sports applications should be signed off by Meika Isgrove.
- Submit a hard copy in an envelope marked "FOTS Discretionary Fund" to the school office by the deadline.
- Contact Jacky Carr or the FOTS Discretionary Fund Sub-Committee (fots@my.brownsbay.school.nz) with any questions before your application is submitted.

What are the timings?

- Deadline for receipt of applications at the school office is by 3pm on Friday, 14 June 2019.
- Successful applicants will be notified by Friday, 28 June 2019.
- Allocated funding must be used by the end of Term 3 2019.
