STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

We want to acknowledge and congratulate one of our Year 6 students, William Keesing, for his outstanding academic achievement. 


MOVE-A-THON

It is great to see students getting involved in the Move-a-thon. Each day students are "moving" for 10 minutes at school and 10 minutes at home to meet their sponsorship goals.

The funds raised will go towards the long-term project of providing an artificial turf area on the asphalt courts and field. This is a significant project for the school community and will require fundraising to achieve it.

A draft outline of the project is shown below:



The Senior Courts:

- Artificial Turf over the Asphalt.
- New Basketball / Netball hoops will be purchased.

The Field:

- The Artificial Turf area consists of a field area for a court and artificial grass connecting the Hard court to the Field; and connecting the Field to the playgrounds.
- A low-level fence (1m) will be built between the Turf and the Field to direct children to the path and away from crossing the Turf with muddy shoes.
- The plan is to have markings for a Futsal field, with Netball and Basketball.
- New Basketball / Netball hoops will be purchased.

The project is planned for late 2024 or early 2025 depending on funds raised.


