Dear Parents and Caregivers Kia Ora

Thank you for attending the Conferences last week. Over the two days we hosted 570 meetings between teachers, parents and students to share learning and achievement. ### **SCHOOL ASSEMBLY**

Next week (August 14<sup>th</sup>) we are returning to the Friday School Assembly yet there will be some changes. The Assembly will be split into a Junior and Senior Assembly:

We have decided on this change due to the increasing number of children on the School Roll (currently at 691 pupils). When we add in teachers and parents to our Assemblies the number starts to reach 800 which is too many people for the School Hall.






With this new integration in the future you will be able to:


### FAMILY MOVIE NIGHT #1 - ABOMINABLE (G) - SOLD OUT
