TEACHER ONLY DAY

TOMORROW 04 JUNE is a Teacher Only Day. This is a day provided under the Teachers Collective Agreement for teachers to use for Professional Learning. The School will not be open for students tomorrow. I hope you all have a pleasant holiday weekend and look forward to seeing everyone on Tuesday 08 June.

ROAD SAFETY

I am becoming increasingly concerned at the traffic behaviour on the roads around the school. I am receiving regular reports about unsafe behaviours and this past week we have seen and have had reports of:



- A Year 2 student being dropped off on Masterton Road while the car is double parked 3 metres from the crossing
- A <u>car blocking the footpath</u> on Masterton Road by parking so the driver can run across the road to collect their child
- A neighbour calling the school to advise us she nearly knocked a girl over that ran <u>between the cars after school</u>. She wants us to know and reiterate the dangers of traffic crossing to the children
- Parents <u>crossing the road with small children</u> within sight of the patrolled pedestrian crossing

We have three to four staff on duty in the morning and afternoons, supervising the pedestrian crossings and the drop off bay to make sure there are safe options for our families.

Young children learn by example and will copy what you do. Unfortunately when it comes to crossing a busy road they do not have the experience or judgement to make the safest decisions. Please encourage safe road practice by following the road rules and using the Pedestrian Crossings.



CLAIMING BACK YOUR DONATION TAX REBATE

You can claim back 33.33c for every dollar you spend on donations (where donations are greater than \$5). Here's how to find your KINDO school donation receipts for this years' tax rebate claim:

Log in to myKindo.co.nz and go to My Orders.

Choose record type 'Donation Receipts'.

Set the date range

Select *Download Summary for IRD tax return* to get a PDF document suitable for attaching to your tax return (containing all school donation amounts paid in the year). Individual donation receipts can also be downloaded as required, or several can be selected and downloaded into a zip file.

NOTE: Kindo cannot change the details on your donation receipt, so please ensure your Account Holder name is correct BEFORE paying any donations. Donation receipts will only be issued for items that the school has nominated as 'donation receipt required'.
