COVID-19 UPDATE

It was positive news to hear the Government announcement earlier in the week of a possible decrease in Lockdown restrictions in Auckland.

We are also waiting on a decision from the Ministry of Education on whether primary schools can open. The Ministry have been discussing with Auckland Principals the implications of opening the schools and how it could be managed. The information the Ministry are gathering will hopefully guide us in a safe decision for our children and staff. Today I am attending an Auckland Principal Zoom to hear some of the thinking and share our ideas.

We are all hoping a decision will be made early so we can prepare the school and children to return to school.

It can be confusing with the different Alert levels, so I have placed the link to the

Covid websites below. At the moment we are still at Alert Level 3. It is really important that we do follow the public guidelines, (especially around the meeting of people outside your Bubble), to ensure the spread of the virus is limited.

DISTANCE LEARNING

Zoom sessions are proving to be popular with students and teachers are reporting a high rate of attendance. As well as the educational benefits of these Zooms, it is a really important way for the children to keep in contact with their teacher and classmates.

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We know the children are missing their friends so if you would like to set up a special Zoom for your child with a friend and do not know the email address of the friend then please email me and I will forward the message on to the parents.

As well as attending Zooms we would also like to encourage children to complete a variety of activities that are available. It helps student learning if they attempt different learning activities over the week in the curriculum areas such as Reading Express, reading by themselves, Zoom reading, reading grid activity. The different activities help reinforce concepts and also ensure they do not get bored just doing one type of activity.

We are continuing with our Bubble classes at school and have four full bubbles. If the decision to open retail changes your home circumstances next week, can you please contact me at peterm@brownsbay.school.nz – I will need to know your children's names and the days they will be at school. Please note we will endeavour to meet the needs of the Community yet it does require some organisation to set up Bubbles. If we have to set up a new Bubble for a group, parents may have to wait a couple of days before we are ready. Each Bubble needs to be staffed by a person who has had a recent negative Covid Test and the results for these can take up to 48 hours to come through.

The Woodview team are doing a great job and the concrete pour was completed without a hitch. The building is very solid and taking shape. A crane will be onsite soon to help set up the iron girders and as you can see the concrete has been poured for the Level 1 floor.



The Woodview team are setting up the steel framing and the size and shape of the building is certainly becoming obvious.
