COVID-19

Term 1 ends on Wednesday 13 April and Term 2 begins on Monday 02 May. It has been a steady term of schooling apart from Omicron causing home isolation and sickness for some families. The number of school cases this week has dropped considerably, and I hope it is an indicator of a more "normal" Term 2. I can report that from April 02 to April 07 we had 2 students who tested positive over that week.

We have one support staff and one teacher who have tested positive or are in home isolation. I was pleased to see 94% of our students at school today learning in their classrooms.

The Government will be updating the Covid-19 Levels on 14 April. If the Level is lowered to Orange, then I will advise parents of the changes before school starts on 02 May.

REPORTING TO PARENTS

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This year, as part of our Recovery Learning plan following the disruptions of the previous years, teachers have completed assessments on children this term to determine where they are with their learning. In a normal assessment cycle these assessments would have been done at the end of last year but due to the split days in the later part of 2021 this was not possible.

Teachers will be available for Parent Conferences in Week 3 of Term 2 (May 18 and 19) to share with parents and caregivers the students next learning steps. The organisation for these Conferences will be sent out at the start of Term 2.

There are a small number of students whom the teachers have been unable to assess due to lack of attendance at school. The parents of these students will be advised of this, and their mid-year report will be later in the Year (possibly early Term 3).

I would like to welcome our new students and Jane Kelly to Browns Bay School. This group is forming our latest class in Room 12.




STAFF NEWS
